

## AMENDMENT FORM

### Suggestion for amendment of Article III-33 bis

1. Workers, employers or their respective organisations shall have the right to take sympathetic action across the borders of the Member States. This right only applies when the primary action is allowed according to national legislation or practise.
2. Restrictions in the right laid down in paragraph 1 shall only be allowed on grounds of public policy, public security and public health.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Paragraph 1: The right to take sympathetic action across national borders within the Union is established. The right is only applicable if the primary conflict is allowable in the Member State where it is taken. For a more extensive commentary on the necessity to regulate sympathetic action in the constitutional treaty we refer to a previous contribution by members of the convention (CONV 515/03).

Paragraph 2: Grounds on which the above-mentioned right may be limited in Union- or Member State-legislation are regulated.
