Insert a new paragraph 2:

“2. The principle of free movement of goods may not be interpreted as affecting in any way the exercise of fundamental rights as recognised by the Member States and Union, including the right or freedom to strike or other collective action covered by the specific industrial relations systems in the Member States and the Union”.

Explanation (if any) :

It is important to clearly state the limits of this freedom in respect to the fundamental rights including the right to strike. The wording is based on Article 2 of Council Regulation (EC) N° 2679/98 of 7 December 1998 on the functioning of the internal market in relation to the free movement of goods among the Member States.
