CHAPTER 4: RESTRICTIVE MEASURES

Article 31

1. Where a decision on a Union position or action adopted according to the provisions on the common foreign and security policy in Chapter 1 of this Title provides for the interruption or reduction, in part or completely, of economic and financial relations with one or more third countries, the Council, acting by a qualified majority on a joint proposal from the [*Minister of Foreign Affairs/Secretary of the Union*] and the Commission, shall take the necessary measures. It shall inform the European Parliament thereof.
 2. In the areas referred to in paragraph 1 the Council may adopt restrictive measures under the same procedure against natural or legal persons and non-State groups or bodies, *including measures to restrict entry into the EU.*

Explanation:

The sanctions applicable should also included the prohibition of entry into the Union's
