**PART I, TITLE V
Article X**

Solidarity clause

~~In application of the principle of solidarity, the Union shall mobilise all the instruments at its disposal, including military resources, to:~~

- ~~— prevent the terrorist threat;~~
- ~~— protect democratic institutions and the civilian population from any terrorist attack;~~
- ~~— assist a Member State in its territory at the request of its political authorities in the event of a terrorist attack.~~

~~The detailed rules for implementing this provision appear in Article X of Part Two, Title B, of the Constitution.~~

Solidarity clause

1. In accordance with the solidarity principle, the Union shall mobilise all means at its disposal, including military resources, measures under the common police and judicial policies as well as civil protection measures, in order to
 - Avert the terrorist threat in the territory of the Union
 - Protect the democratic institutions and the civilian population in the Union, in case of a terrorist attack
 - Assist a Member State which has been the victim of terrorist attack within its territory, at the request of this Member State's civilian authorities.
2. In case of an armed attack against a Member State participating to the Common Security and Defence Policy, the Union solidarity as described in paragraph 1 shall apply, at the request of the authorities of this Member State.

The details of the implementation of this provision are set in Article X, Part II, Title B of the Constitution.
