Subject : **Answers from Mr Speroni, Member of the Convention, to the President's priorities issues.**

Answers from Mr Speroni to the President's priorities issues.

1. It should be defined as an area of voluntary accessories intervention by the EU in co-operation with Member States interested.
2. We should add international sports activities and delete education (instruction).
3. This subject should be added eventually not in a Treaty but in a Constitution.
4. The term "complementary" should be substituted: the matter should not refer to the complementary attributes but to the main term. For competencies, it is intended those referred to in legislative procedures.
5. It is opportune to develop the idea of our colleague Heatcoat-Amory. If his idea, to abolish articles 94 and 95, should not get a majority consensus we should define and limit its impact.
6. Article 308 must be revoked, as it is imprecise and without limit.
The Constitution must foresee another way, more clear and restrictive, of how the EU must respond to unpredictable and exceptional situations. In all cases the EP must first ratify the decision.
7. It is best to leave Article 6 paragraph 3 in its actual form.
